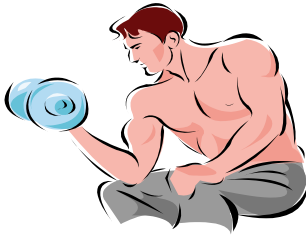

Perennials For Sun And Shade

Now is the time to consider planting color in your garden that will repay you each and every year. I'm talking about perennials, a plant that will regrow year after year and reward you with great blooms, foliage and more.

Many perennials will “die back” to the ground each winter but “regrow” each spring to a larger size than the year before, ultimately growing to maturity in 2-3 years.

SUN LOVING PERENNIALS

Two proven winners for northeast Oklahoma are Moonbeam Coreopsis and Veronica. Veronica has blue flowers that show in April– May and grows 12-18” tall. It is a profuse bloomer with its buds born on top of the foliage. Moonbeam is a dainty open plant with lots of tiny yellow blooms 1/4” across. These

blooms will be seen from mid summer till the first frost.

SHADE TOLERANT PERENNIALS

Astilbe has leaves that are twice or thrice compound, grows 2-3' tall and blooms either white, pink or red. Astilbe reproduces every 3 years. It grows best in part shade.

Peonies are a shade tolerant plant that bloom in late spring and early summer. These grow on the east and north sides or with afternoon shade and produce blooms that are up to 12” across. Flowers can be many shades of pink, red and also come in white. **CONSIDER PERENNIALS FOR YOUR GARDEN THIS YEAR AND WATCH THEM GROW.** There are many more to choose from that will satisfy any flower garden lover.
